ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Effectively contributed to the WTO negotiations
- Identified categories A, B, C measures
- Recognised as among the first countries to notify Category A measures and accepted the Amendment of the Marrakesh Agreement.

CHALLENGES:

- Lack of effective participation by some key stakeholders
- Lack of consistency in representation by the stakeholders
